<u>Water Delivery Issue Calls for</u> <u>Urgent Conservation</u>

PCWA recently received notification from PG&E of a delay in repairs to essential water delivery infrastructure at Lake Spaulding. This delay is substantial enough to trigger actions by PCWA to conserve water until PG&E's repair is complete and water is restored.

PCWA is asking all customers to reduce water use by 20% to help manage this ongoing water delivery issue. Since Christian Valley Park, CSD, receives raw water from PCWA, your actions to conserve will help PCWA preserve the existing water supply during this critical time.

We understand how important it is to maintain your landscape, especially during the hotter months. With rising temperatures, it's crucial to use water wisely indoors and outdoors to ensure a reliable supply for everyone.

Simple things you can do to conserve water include: reduce sprinkler cycles by two minutes, adjust sprinklers to prevent overspray, water early in the morning, and fix household leaks.

Thank you for your cooperation and commitment to water conservation during this critical time.

New Water Rates

On July 1st, the water rate adjustment passed by the Christian Valley Park, CSD, Board of Directors took effect. The rate adjustment schedule is provided below. The District bills customers quarterly such that each bill represents three months of water service.
